WHO ARE WE ? WHAT DO WE DO ? WHAT DOES IT COST?

- St James Priory is the oldest building in Bristol and dates from 1129.
- St James Priory Project is the not for profit Charity which manages all our work.
- The Charity offers support for vulnerable people in early recovery from addiction.
- These vulnerable people are aided with individual support and housing.
- Housing & support is provided in St James House.
- St James House is an independent registered HMO for 10 people in recovery from addiction. Residents can stay for up to 24 months.
- In the 24months residents are expected to find educational courses and / or voluntary work.
- Voluntary work provides individuals with a sense of purpose and a commitment to positive action.
- Positive action brings affirmation and increased self esteem.
- Improved self esteem cements ongoing recovery and stability.
- Stability in housing is enhanced by residents moving on to their own accommodation.
- Accommodation at Walsingham House provides support for men with mental health problems and is run by St Mungos who lease the building from us.

- The Priory Church is the heart of the Project.
- It is a place of healing, peace and reconciliation and is open from Monday – Friday between 10am until 5pm.
- Mass is celebrated every Sunday at 8am.
- Eucharistic Adoration from 12.30 – 15.30.
- It is a very important Historical site not only locally but also nationally.
- We estimate that it costs £200 per day to keep the church open.
- We rely heavily on donations to maintain this historic Church and to continue the charitable work of the Project in supporting vulnerable people.
- Cafe Réfectoire is part of St James Priory and provides a revenue for the Charity.
- It is an Independent Artisan Café providing great coffee, great food in a light & bright setting.
- It is a good place to meet & greet.
- There are Meeting Rooms for hire adjacent to the Café.
