ST JAMES HOUSE

Residents had a difficult time during Covid and some were unsettled by the restrictions imposed by the Government. They were also negatively impacted by the sudden departure of our Support Worker.

At present there is a settled and close group in the House who are providing valuable support for each other.

We have continued our upgrading programme for the property. In this we are indebted to our new volunteer, Alex, who has repainted most of the House internally in a very short space of time.

- We are still committed to upgrade residents rooms one at a time.
- It costs £3,000 for each room.

The service provides individuals with housing and general support during their time as residents. There is an expectation that they are involved in voluntary work and/or education and attend recovery meetings.

Residents, who need to be clean & sober are provided with support for up to 3 years now. However, with the shortage of social housing and an increased demand for move on accommodation some have been given support for much longer.
